

General Terms & Conditions

1. Registration

Registration for the UbiQancer International Conference is completed via the online registration system. Registration becomes binding upon receipt of full payment. The registration fee includes access to the scientific program, as well as coffee breaks, lunch, and finger food during the poster session.

2. Payment

The fee has to be transferred within 15 days after Registration, but no later than 1 February 2027. Registrations for which payment has not been received by the deadline may be cancelled.

3. Cancellation

All cancellations must be submitted in writing and sent to the conference manager via email (UbiQancer-conference.3m@mri.tum.de). For cancellations made by February 1, the registration fee will be refunded on a prorated basis. An administrative fee of €50 will be charged for cancellations received before 1 February 2027. No refunds can be granted for cancellations received after 1 February 2027.

4. Program Changes

The organizers reserve the right to modify the program, schedule, or speakers as necessary. This includes the right to modify session times, replace speakers, and adjust the order of presentations. Such changes may be made without prior notice.

5. Cancellation or Modification of the Event

The organizers reserve the right to cancel, postpone, or modify the conference due to unforeseen circumstances, including force majeure events, travel restrictions, public health measures, and other events beyond the organizers' control. Participants will be informed as soon as possible in such cases. The conference organizers cannot be held liable for any damages, costs, or losses incurred as a result of such cancellation, postponement, or modification, including travel and accommodation expenses. Any potential reimbursement of registration fees will be determined based on the circumstances at the time of cancellation or modification.
